

Call for proposals by PLN foundation and Netherlands Heart Institute

Help PLN de wereld uit

PLN Foundation and Netherlands Heart Institute award the most promising idea to Cure PhosphoLambaN insufficiency:

Project type

- Activities by PhDs/Post-Docs;
- Duration 6-12 months; Budget 25-50 K€ per project;
- Start of project before September 1st 2017.

Criteria

- The PLN call is open for applications that are novel (not part of already funded work) and that advance solving the PLN disease
- Projects should be multi-center
- The focus should be on adding knowledge and working towards the clinic
- Having the potential of generating future funding, for example by generating pilot data, by initiating or strengthening collaborations are preferred.
- Applicants need to be available for the pitch to be given on Friday June 30 between 10.00h. and 12.00h. in Utrecht.

Proposal template

- Proposals should be written in English, using the template on the following pages.
- Proposals should describe: the working plan, the hypothesis, the activities, output.
- Additionally, a complete budget should be presented as well as your CV. The format for the CV is based on the Dutch VENI CV format; however, this PLN call is open to PhD students and Post-Docs.

Process and deadline

We expect the costs for salary and materials to exceed the amounts awarded in these grants. Therefore, your institution should commit scientifically and financially to your proposal. In case your project is granted, this commitment will be a condition before your project can start.

The evaluation and ranking of the projects will be done by the boards of the PLN foundation and the Netherlands Heart Institute.

Six projects will be invited to present the project on Friday June 30 between 10.00h. and 12.00h. at our *2017 scientific congress*, where the final decision will be made public by invited experts and the PLN foundation. <https://congress2017.heart-institute.nl/>
